2008 Sonoma Coast Chardonnay

Rich, viscous texture, stone fruit flavors of peach and apricot, tropical fruit, Fuji apple and white flower aromatics. Layers of tangerine, Bosc pear, peach and hazelnut, resulting in a lithe, layered and complex wine.

2009 Hyde Vineyard Chardonnay

Richly textured with beautiful density and depth. The nose offers classic Hyde notes of marmalade and ginger, with layers of cedar and smoke adding a complex counterpoint. On the palate, the citrus and orange peel flavors combine with notes of fresh summer fruits and spices.

2009 Chenoweth Ranch Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

Notes of strawberry and cherry, along with a depth and density that hints at its exceptional ageability, with mouthcoating layers of dark chocolate, smoke and cedar complemented by lovely elements of violet and lavender.

2009 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir

Beautiful layers of cherry, raspberry, cedar, clove and cinnamon, as well as floral notes of rose and carnation. Creamy, rich tannins, along with a bright acidity that penetrates the tannins and keeps the wine light and lively.
