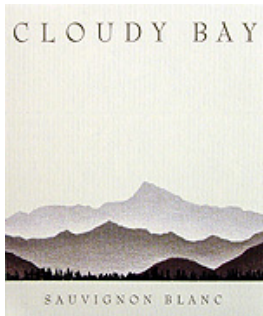

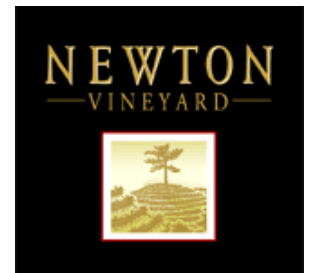
Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc has deliciously vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of fresh passion fruit and juicy pineapples with garden-fresh basil and the spiciness of crushed tomato leaves. The palate is long and succulent, combining exotic fruits with ripe, red capsicum and a twist of green olive. The wine that put New Zealand on the map!

Sterling Vineyards Mendocino Chardonnay opens with Fuji apple, white peach and pineapple. Well-balanced oak appears in the guise of sweet vanilla custard, which softens the fruit intensity. The finish is clean with pleasant citrus notes.



Lapostolle Casa Carmenera has a deep dark red color with intense aromas of spices, herbs and fruit. Juicy and smooth tannins which are a wonderful match for modern food. Confused as Merlot, or used just as a blender, in the last ten years Carmenera has finally stepped out into the spot light.

Newton Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon has layers of black plum, white chocolate, vanilla and anise aromas leap from the glass, accented by an appealing hint of violets. On the palate, smoky plum, blackberry and supple leather flavors are surrounded by smooth yet substantial tannins. Inaugural vintage of this wine.
