Chardonnay

Charles Krug Napa Sauvignon Blanc 2009	29 ⁹⁵
<i>Aromas of honeydew, peach and pear perk the senses. The palate is delicate with seamless balance and crisp acidity.</i>	
Michael David 6th Sense Syrah	29 ⁹⁵
<i>Striking aromas of ripe dark fruits radiate from the glass in an earthy, smoky tobacco context. Full, rich fruit flavors of dark berries, whole plum, and blackcurrant fill the palate and hold their flavors through a long and smooth moderately peppery finish.</i>	
St. Francis Claret	35 ⁹⁵
<i>A blend of Merlot, Cabernet & Zinfandel, this Sonoma beauty is full bodied and elegant at the same time. Cedar, vanilla and toffee flavors throughout.</i>	
Patz & Hall Jenkins Ranch Pinot Noir 2007	36 ⁹⁵
<i>This is an amazing Pinot Noir with an elegant texture that balances lushness with a certain demure quality. It is smooth and creamy, with an easy drinking charm that highlights raspberry, cherry and pomegranate flavors. Wine Enthusiast 94 points.</i>	
Cain Cuvee NV 7	40 ⁹⁵
<i>A blend of 46% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc and 9% Petit Verdot. The Cain Cuvee reflects a vision of what a classic red wine can be. Drawing from mountain and valley, as well as two vintages, the wine is one of aromatic complexity that is truly silky and sits lightly and refreshingly on the palate.</i>	
Sequoia Grove 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon	51 ⁹⁵
<i>Dark red-black in color with intense aromas of blackberry, black cherry, and currants. Additional layers on the nose of rich spice with added hints of vanilla and maple. On the palate flavors of sweet ripe raspberries come through and the wine has smooth tannins and creamy weight with an impeccable balance and a long finish. Staff favorite!</i>	
Swanson Vineyards 2007 Oakville Merlot	51 ⁹⁵
<i>Very tightly-focused ode to the wines of the Right Bank of Bordeaux. The nose offers mocha and black cherry. Firm, sweet, silky tannins, raspberry, black cherry and red licorice contribute to the complex flavors.</i>	
Stags' Leap Winery Petite Syrah 2006	53 ⁹⁵
<i>Blackberry and black plums integrated with layers of maple syrup, crème brulee and a hint of earth. Dark and inky with a full jammy flavor.</i>	
Hanna Bismark Zinfandel 2004	65 ⁹⁵
<i>Fruit forward, big and delicious. This Zinfandel showcases heady aromas of blackberry, toasty oak and spice. Select blocks of Zinfandel add layers of flavor. A mouthful of rich and dynamic wine. A staff favorite</i>	
Fantesca Chardonnay 2008	70 ⁹⁵
<i>This is the only Chardonnay made by celebrated wine maker Heidi Barrett, and is her first new wine project since leaving Screaming Eagle. Russian River fruit produces a truly floral, eminently balanced, custard and creamy Chardonnay, long on the finish.</i>	
Newton The Puzzle 2005	89 ⁹⁵
<i>35% Cabernet Franc, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Merlot, 9% Petit Verdot Opens with rich aromas of cassis and touches of raspberries, dark chocolate and kirsch cherries. On the palate, expect a velvety explosion of blackberries, raspberry liquor, black fig and dark cherry bolstered by ripe tannins. 94 points - The Wine Advocate.</i>
